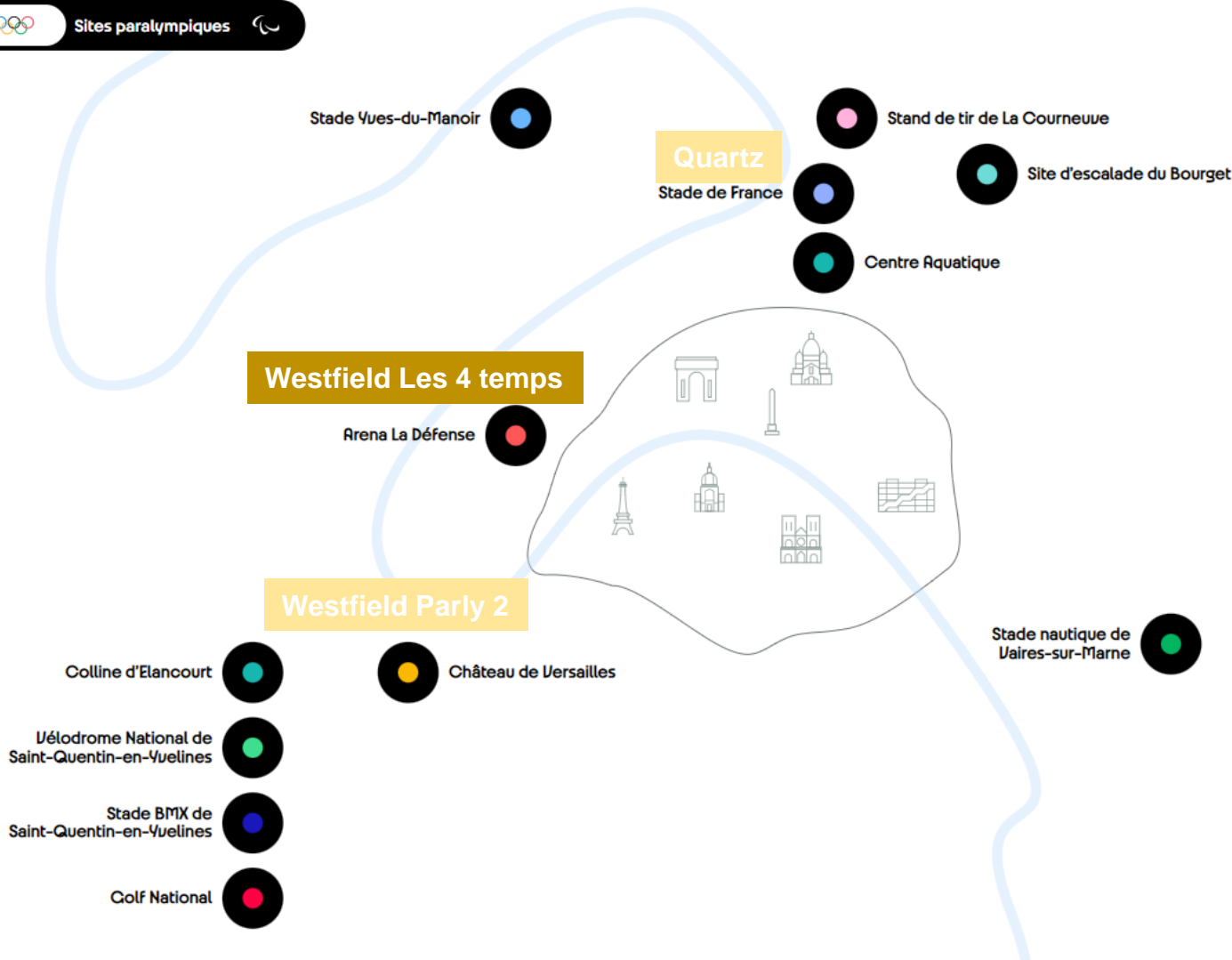
### Forum des Halles
